Description

We will be working alongside The Other Ones Foundation - an organization partnering with the city to employ the homeless to clean up abandoned homeless camps.

We will start promptly at 9:30am and work in teams until a little before noon. The Other Ones take lunch break from 12:00 to 12:30.

Children

Children 8 years or older, able to navigate rough outdoor terrain, are welcome to come with their parents. At least one parent must supervise and stay with each child at all times.

Teenage Minors

Minors are welcome, as long as an adult parent or guardian is present to supervise and sign the PARD liability waiver for them.

What Will Be Provided

Safety vests, gloves, trash bags, dust masks, pruning clippers (for vines and light brush), bottled water.

What To Wear

Rugged closed toe shoes (to protect from any broken glass or other sharp objects), pants (to protect from brush and stickers).

Don't wear necklaces, dangling ear-rings, or other loose items that could get lost or caught in vines. If you have long loose hair you may want to pull it back or put it in a pony tail.

You may want to wear a hat and/or sunscreen. Bring your own insecticide.

Food / Water / Bathrooms

Bottled water will be provided.

Weather

If the weather looks to be raining or wet, an email of cancellation will be sent out the evening before or the morning of the event, and we will reschedule to another time.
